Unlike many in the whisky industry, all Bakery Hill malt whiskies are single cask expressions and matured in American Oak barrels for at least six to eight years.

The tasting experience is truly unforgettable.

Bakery Hill is a proudly independent, family-owned malt whisky distillery in Melbourne, Australia.

Established in 1999, Bakery Hill has since built a reputation as one of the finest premium malt whisky distilleries in the world.

In 2005, Bakery Hill was named 'Best Small Distillery Whisky of the Year' in Jim Murray's Whisky Bible.

More recently, Bakery Hill Peated Malt Cask Strength was awarded 'Southern Hemisphere Whisky of the Year' in Jim Murray's Whisky Bible 2020.

The distillery has also received outstanding reviews from the Whisky Magazine, Malt Whisky Yearbook, Vogue Entertaining & Travel, the Bulletin and The Age Epicure.

# Belgian Double Wood

Abv. 55.25%

Colour Golden Cedar

Nose Caramel, Green Apples, Bubblegum, Licorice, Butterscotch

Palate Peanut Butter, Dark Chocolate, Sweet Raisins, Vanilla, Coffee

Finish Lovely length, liquid legs clinging to the glass, Long and full, with Malted Milk and Caramel.

**Overview** In 2012, a Belgian Maltster offered David Baker the chance to buy Pilsen Malt - a type of barley rarely used for whisky.

David developed custom milling and brewing techniques to showcase the malt's distinctive character, before resting the whisky in American Oak for six years (equivalent to 12 cold years in Scotland).

The whisky then spent another 11 months in virgin French Oak, resulting in a complex, gentle but demanding whisky that's hard to forget.

# Classic Malt

## Abv.

46%

## Colour

Light translucent gold.

## Nose

A complex multi-layering of sweet green apples and spiced honey with a hint of cider

## Palette

The flavour ramps up kaleidoscopically, from nutmeg through spiced honey to a firm cereal, with a generous layer of malty richness to finish.

## Finish

Mouth filling, smooth and lingering, leaving a satisfying glow of inner warmth.

# Double Wood

**Abv.**  
46%

**Colour**  
A rich burnished bronze.

**Nose**  
The nose opens with the slightest hint of apricot, coconut and plum, before revealing an intermingling of golden syrup and plum pudding. All wrapped in the spicy hint of cloves.


**Palette**  
Subdued and mouth filling. Orange marmalade overtones with characteristic rich nougat sweetness and well balanced oak.

**Finish**  
Rounded and well finished, lingering to the very end.

# Peated Malt

**Abv.**  
46%

**Colour**  
Rich gold russet of evening sunset.

**Nose**  
A rich, subdued peat aroma combined with a natural leathery earthiness and overtones of kumquat.

**Palette**  
The palette reveals a tobacco leaf earthiness with layer upon layer of complex smoky peat that lingers on the lips.

**Finish**  
Astonishingly long and complex. An exotic mix of experiences.

# Classic Malt Cask Strength

**Abv.**  
60%

**Colour**  
Rich amber gold.

**Nose**  
An intensely sweet, satin smooth malt with overtones of vanilla, almond meal and sweet jaffa orange, all intermingled with rich dark chocolate.

**Palette**  
The palette is recognisant of spiced orange Turkish Delight with a mouth cleansing zestiness intermingled with fresh malty cereal and chunky oak. Rich and sweet but not cloying. A brilliant balance of sensations.

**Finish**  
The finish is deep and enveloping with lingering malt richness.

# Peated Malt Cask Strength

## Abv.

60%

## Colour

Golden cedar.

## Nose

Intense peat without being over the top. This expression is rich with crisp salt with overtones of dark cherry and natural earthiness. Complex but delicate; a well balanced single malt.

## Palette

A cascading experience of flavor explosions. Toffee, honeycomb and rich malt, gently warming with a suggestion of peat saltiness.

## Finish

Immensely satisfying, well rounded and lingering. A mouth filling sensation that remains long after the dram has departed.
